



Tri-County Trail Riders, Inc. *Rules*

Here are some rules we have to keep everyone safe, as well as to ensure the longevity of the club trails.

1. You must **STAY ON THE TRAIL!!** If you wander off the trail for whatever reason, we can lose it. Respect the land owners please. Remember the trails are a privilege not a right.
2. You must wear a helmet at **ALL TIMES!**
3. You must obey all trail signs. If you are caught speeding in posted areas, you will get a ticket.
4. If you want to ride double, you must have a “permanently mounted seat” on the back of your machine.
5. If you are under 16, and are out on the trails. You must be on an "age appropriate machine". You must also be with an adult, or have a ATV safety course certificate with you.
6. When you are riding along the bike/walking trail. Please respect other people by slowing down when near them. If the town gets complaints about us flying by them and dusting them out. We might lose that part of the trail.
7. If you continue on another trail that is **NOT** part of our trail, you are on your own.
8. You **must** be a member to ride our trails. Always carry a copy of your Reg/Ins/ and club sticker/card with you. If you get stopped and are not a member, you can get a ticket for trespassing.
